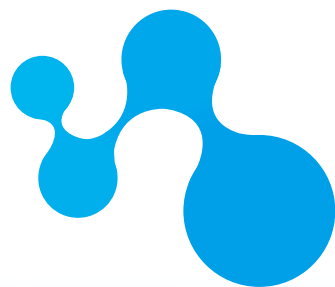

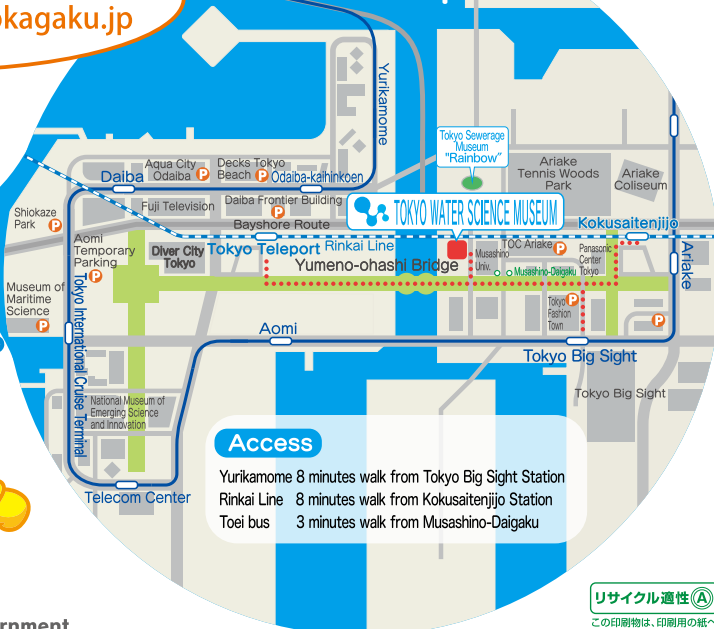

- During your visit**
- The visitation route begins at the "Aqua Trip" on the 3rd floor.
 - Museum visits are unguided.
 - If you have any questions, ask the nearest attendant.
 - Smoking is not allowed in the museum.
 - Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
 - For a safe visit, please follow the "12 Promises".
- 12 Promises**
- ① Don't run
 - ② Don't climb on the exhibits
 - ③ Don't jump off from the exhibits
 - ④ Don't throw things
 - ⑤ Watch your step
 - ⑥ Don't hit
 - ⑦ Don't hang from places
 - ⑧ Don't touch any controls in places other than where directed
 - ⑨ Don't play around with the museum's equipment
 - ⑩ Don't spill water or splash your friends
 - ⑪ Don't lean over rails
 - ⑫ Don't cut in line

Water, forests and all the creatures that live there.



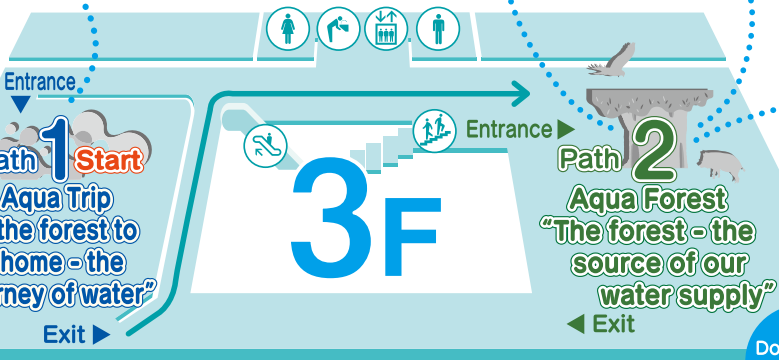

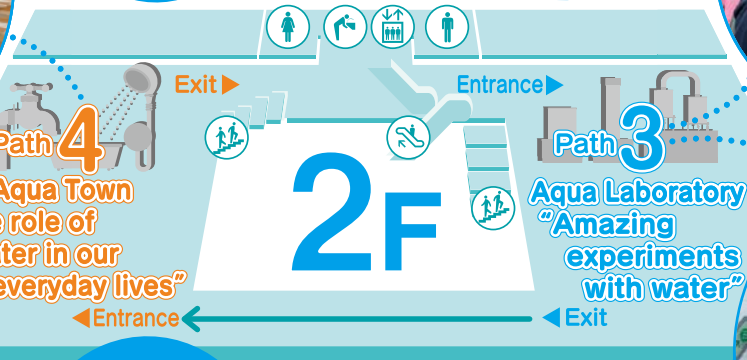
